## How to prepare and submit requests to present

Abstracts must be submitted for all presentations: invited talks, oral presentations and posters. Symposium attendees may present up to a maximum of one oral and one poster presentation. However, you may be listed as a non-presenting author on any number of presentations, or second author on any number of posters.

The organising committee hopes to be able to accept all submitted oral presentations, but in the interest of time, if too many oral presentations are submitted, we may request that some be presented as posters. The times allotted for invited talks and general oral presentations, including time for questions, are 30 – 45 minutes and 15 minutes, respectively.

Abstract submission should adhere to the following guidelines. You may also use the attached Abstract\_Template, substituting the current text with your own.

- ◆ **Page format:** A4.
- ◆ **Text:** All text should be in standard lower case, left-aligned and justified, with 1.25-inch (3.2 cm) left and right margins.
- ◆ **Session:** Request either an oral or a poster presentation, and suggest a session in which to present (the final decision will be made by the scientific committee).
- ◆ **Title:** Arial, 14 pt, bold.
- ◆ **Author names:** Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold. Given name(s) first, followed by family name(s); author names separated by commas; family name(s) in all uppercase. Underline the presenter's name.
- ◆ **Affiliations and Addresses:** Times New Roman, 10 pt. Use superscript numbers to associate authors' institutions. Provide an email address of the presenter or corresponding author.
- ◆ **Main text:** Times New Roman, lower case, 11 pt. 250 words maximum.
- ◆ **Keywords:** List up to six terms not already found in the title, in alphabetical order, separated by semicolons; Times New Roman, 11 pt.

## Special issues and Proceedings

Three venues have been selected for publication of symposium contributions: *Insect Science* (ISI indexed; 15-20 articles), the *European Journal of Environmental Sciences* (15-20 articles; thanks to Dr Pavel Kindlmann's kind offer), and the 9ISA proceedings. All contributions will be submitted to peer review. Editors, considering reviewers' recommendations and thematic value of special journal issues, will select the publication venue. In order to guide the decision-making process, please indicate on your registration form, your preferred venue.

## Travel information

### Visa application

If you need an official invitation letter from the 9ISA organising committee to support your visa application to China, please send an email request to [beijing.9isa@hotmail.com](mailto:beijing.9isa@hotmail.com) with your full name, title, institutional affiliation, and professional address.

### Transportation

There are two convenient options for getting to the hotel from the Beijing Capital International Airport (BCIA) (<http://en.bcia.com.cn/>). The distance between the hotel and the airport is about 27 kilometers.

**Taxi.** The cost of a taxi from the BCIA to the hotel is approximately ¥85 per car (can be shared by up to three passengers) but will depend on traffic, time of day (before 6:00 AM and after 23:00 PM is more expensive), etc. You can tell the driver your destination is “Ya Ao Jiu Dian (亚奥酒店)” or “Lao Dong Da Sha (劳动大厦)” in Chinese Pinyin, or show the driver a map with the location of the hotel.

**Airport Shuttle Bus.** There are several lines between the airport (each of the three terminals) and landmarks in different parts of Beijing city, back and forth. The terminal of Line 6 (BCIA <-> Ya Ao Jiu Dian) is the symposium hotel !!! The cost of a ticket is ¥16.
